- ✓ We contribute to the protection of local properties and sites that are historically, archaeologically, culturally or spiritually important, facilitating the access of local residents to them.
- ✓ We use elements of art, architecture or local cultural heritage in our operations, design, decoration, food or stores; at the same time as we respect the intellectual property rights of local communities.
